Love & Logic is a philosophy of raising and teaching children which allows adults to be happier, empowered and more skilled in the interactions with children. Love & Logic is a way of working with children that puts parents and teachers back in control, teaches children to be responsible, and prepares young people for the real world, with its many choices and consequences.

It offers adults an alternative way to communicate with children. The techniques produce immediate results because the techniques are simple, practical, and easy to learn. Curriculum is presented in six sessions. A social worker and guidance counselor from Watertown Unified School District (WUSD) staff provide professional instruction.

Free Childcare for children birth to 10 years of age is available for participants.

Fall Session: 10/12; 10/19; 10/26; 11/2; 11/9; 11/16

Classes are on Thursday evenings 6 - 7:30 pm. In order to receive a certificate you must attend 4 out of the six classes and be an active participant in class.
